Faculty Homework Policy

Faculty name: Physical Education

Rationale for homework at KS3:

Our main focus is on promoting and encouraging all students to attend sessions highlighted on the extra-curricular programme. Attendance of participation recorded for all sessions to monitor levels of engagement.

Alternative provision - KS3 homework set every week A on Satchel One for all groups. This will focus on different themes including Olympic values, skills from the skills builder programme and other key themes linked to the PE curriculum. Types of homework will replicate the whole school homework policy such as 'Practise it' or 'Retrieve it' tasks and will promote outstanding levels of literacy.

The types of homework tasks that will be set and frequency: (This may include benefits for students)

'Retrieve it' tasks such as, Quick fire 5, multiple choice questions, spelling tests, analysis of performance tasks (via video links).

Homework is set every 2 weeks, easily accessible and relevant to the activity or task.

Rationale for homework at KS4:

KS4 core PE students are encouraged to attend the extra-curricular sessions on offer to them.

Homework is relevant and reinforces the learning taking place in lesson. Sports Studies Unit RO51 and GCSE PE courses are heavy in content and follow a strict time frame, therefore homework is utilised to help students retain, recall and retrieve valuable knowledge in preparation for the written examination.

The types of homework tasks that will be set and frequency: (This may include benefits for students)

'Retrieve it' tasks help students to remember important knowledge and understanding via Satchel One. 'Practise it' tasks may also be set to encourage students to practice skills. KS4 PE examination students are expected to complete homework tasks every 2 weeks.
