Guidance on Acceptable Footwear

We are conscious that this can be a 'grey' area for parents, and in order to help you with this we have provided this guidance.

Basically any shoe that is a trainer, or looks like a trainer, is not permitted. Sensible school shoes need to be worn.

Boots are allowed, but they must not have any visible logos or bright colours. Boots with 'reflector strips' for safety, are allowed.

We have produced these examples to assist you before you buy any new shoes.

The shoes below are examples of those styles that are acceptable for school:

Any styles that vary from these may not be allowed and may result in you being required to purchase additional footwear for your child. Students will be isolated at break/lunch times if incorrect footwear is worn.
