Sunday 31st March

- Meet at school from 5.30am onwards – **please do not be late – we aim to leave school ASAP**
- Depart from school @6am – Journey to Dover for a 14.25 outward sailing to Calais
- On arrival to Calais we will proceed to Premier Classe Hotel Villepinte

Parents should park at the front of school and also use the back car park – **DO NOT Park on Printshop Lane**

Monday 1st April

- Depart from the Hotel Villepinte with a light breakfast on the way
- Breakfast stop enroute
- Onward journey to Spain-several stops
- Once we arrive at the hotel evening meal should be available

Tuesday 2nd April

- Full day in the hotel and resort of Salou
- Use of hotel facilities - Activities to include shopping, football on the beach, use of hotel facilities, pool/games room etc
- Breakfast, Lunch and evening meal available at the hotel

Wednesday 3rd April

- Full day visit to Barcelona with the opportunity to view landmarks including a visit to the home of Barcelona FC
- A visit to the shopping centre at the Port
- Some free time in the resort of Salou
- Breakfast and evening meal included this day

Thursday 4th April

- Full day visit to PortAventura Theme Park – entrance ticket and meal vouchers are included
- Breakfast and evening meal at the hotel included on this day

Friday 5th April

- Free day to use the hotel facilities and the opportunity to do some last minute shopping
- Breakfast, Lunch and an evening meal will be available
- We will depart the resort at around 9pm for an overnight trip back to Paris

Saturday 6th April

- We will stop near to Paris for a wash and change then head to McDonalds for a breakfast – the cost of this is included
- We will the head to Disneyland Paris for the day-students will receive a meal voucher
- At the end of the day we will meet up and head to the hotel Villepinte

Sunday 7th April

- Depart Paris and journey back to Calais for the return ferry crossing to England
- We will supply a breakfast for students and food will be available on the boat
- We will ask the students to keep you updated on arrival times home
- Please do not park on Printshop Lane

Sunday 31st March – we will make stops for food and meals are available to purchase on the Ferry during the crossing – a mixture of £/€'s for the day

Monday 1st April – Money needed for breakfast and food for the journey - €'s

Tuesday 2nd April – Money will be needed for the remainder of the day @the hotel - €'s

Spending Money

Friday 5th April – Full day at the resort and hotel – students may wish to purchase some snacks and souvenirs - €'s

Saturday 8th April – Students may need money for snacks etc at Disneyland - €'s

Sunday 9th April - students will need money for food during the day – meals are available to purchase on the ferry – a mix €/£'s is advisable for this day

Spending Money

We ask that all spending money is put into individual envelopes-one for each day with the students:

***Name**

***Day**

***Amount in € and £**

Clearly written on each envelope

It is advisable that your child's spending money be handed to their group leader on the morning of departure, they will then distribute it each day

We are not responsible for your child's spending money if they do not hand it to their group leader

Envelopes will be available at the end of the presentation

Important Information

- Students Passports will need to be handed in before departure date
- EHIC (medical card) will need to be handed in before departure
- Medication handed to group leader prior to departure – this will need to be clearly marked with your child's name and any specific instructions
- Travel sickness tablets – please hand to your child's group leader on the morning of departure with your child's name clearly marked on the box

Important Information

- Clothing – t-shirts, shorts, swimming shorts/costume, beach towel
- Students will access to the hotel swimming pool but **only** with a member of the school staff present
- Please bring sun cream and after sun
- Please also pack a waterproof jacket/coat
- Bring a blanket and a small pillow for over night travel
- Students will need to walk around in groups of 3 or 4 and not on their own

Important Information

- All students will be expected to dress appropriately during visits to the hotel dining room
- All students will be expected to be on time to meetings and follow the guidelines/rules at all times
- Rooms in the hotels should be clean and tidy at all times – if anything is broken it will need to be reported immediately
- Students will **NOT** be permitted to use any roof top facilities at the hotel
- Students are **NOT** permitted go into other hotel rooms other than their own -
- Please do not ask your child to bring back gifts of alcohol or cigarettes/tobacco

Important Information

- The expectation is that all students are well mannered, polite and behave accordingly at all times during the trip
- Students should not take photos of other students while in the hotel rooms
- There will be lots of other guests/holiday makers at the hotel during our visit
