Health and Safety Policy

- Cooperate with the Company on all health and safety matters.
- To follow all health and safety procedures and instructions and training they have been given.
- Report any health and safety concerns, accidents and near misses to managers.

Miquill believes that a positive health and safety culture directly contributes to the success of the company and its employees; therefore is committed to continuous health and safety improvements and will monitor and review the company's performance. This policy will be reviewed and amended annually or as necessary.

It is the responsibility of all Directors and Senior Managers to ensure that this policy is effectively communicated to all employees.

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
